<sup>S1</sup> HIV/AIDS can hit anyone. You can't tell someone is HIV positive just by looking at him.




HIV is transmitted through unprotected sex, pregnancy or contaminated blood (unsterilized material).

<sup>S4</sup>2/ Unfaithful couples,



Mosquito bites, eating together, shaking hands, kissing, spitting, washing the clothes of an infected person, sharing soap or washing together, using local transports, latrines.
